***Will you not revive us again so that your
people may rejoice in you? Psalms 85:6***

Lord, let revival begin in ME – Week 1 ~ January 6th

- Ask God to create in you a clean heart and renew your spirit as you depend on Him alone as the source of revival; ask him to expose the offensive things hidden in your heart (Psalms 51:10, 1 John 1:9; Psalms 139:23-24)
- Ask God to grant spiritual brokenness, deep conviction of sin and honestly confess your sins before God, name them specifically to Him and asking for forgiveness. Repent of whatever He shows you to be sin. (2. Corinthians 7:10; Joel 2:12-13; 1 John 1:9-10)
- Ask God to sanctify you and so that you can be a vessel of honor; to mortify all the deeds of the flesh so that your worship can be acceptable to him. (1 Thes. 5:3; Romans 8:13)
- Ask God to send a fresh anointing and rebirth of the fruits of the spirit in your life. (Galatians 5:22-23)
- Ask God to transform and renew you urging you to live a sacrificially poured out life, consecrated to him in holiness. (Romans 12:1-2)
- Pray for the revival of the word in your life; pray that God will give you the desire and power to obey Him in every moment. (Psalms 19:7; Daniel 4:34-35; Philippians 2:13; James 1:22-23)
- Ask God to help you to submit to the authority of the Bible, that He will reveal to you any thought, attitude, or action in your life that does not conform to Scripture and to the image of Jesus? (2 Timothy 3:16; James 1:19-27; Galatians 5:16-24)
- Pray that your relationship with God will be first priority. Ask God to teach you to stay close to him like Jesus did, rejecting pride which leads to destruction, and embracing humility which leads to abundant life. (John 14:10-11; John 15:1-17; 1 Peter 5:5-6, 2 Chron. 7:14)
- Ask God to help you to be attentive and obedient to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Ask him to fill you with His power and fullness? (Galatians 5:25; Ephesians 3:16-19)

- Ask God to give you a holy fear of Him. Ask him to help you care more about his opinion than the opinions of others. (Proverbs 1:7; 29:25)
- Ask him to show you the deepness of your need for him, and destroy self-sufficiency. (John 15:5; 2 Corinthians 3:5)
- Ask him to change your mindset so that prayer becomes your first response in every situation; to enlarge the scope of your prayer time with Him; that you will seek him for all things. (Philippians 4:6-7; Matthew 6:33; 2 Chron. 7:14)
- Ask God to increase your faith in his ability to intervene supernaturally in your life; ask God to use you as an instrument for revival (Hebrews 11:6; Mark 9:23; Zach. 8:20-23)
- Ask God for physical healing, but also for spiritual recovery from emotionally hurtful incidents from the past. (James 5:13-16)
- Ask God to make you holy (1 Peter 1:16)
- Ask God to humble you (Gal. 6:3, Phil. 2:5-8, Prov. 29:23)
- Pray for the filling of the Holy Spirit. (Eph. 5:18)
- Ask God to anoint you afresh for service (Luke 4:18-19)
- Ask God to use you (1 Cor. 12:12-30)
- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal and remove idols:
 - Love of money (1 Tim. 6:10)
 - Love of self (2 Tim. 3:2)
 - Love of approval (John 12:42)
 - Love of power or control (3 John 9:10)
 - Love of pleasure (2 Tim. 3:4)
 - Love of darkness (John 3:19)
 - Love of things of the world (1 John 2:15)
- Some areas for reflection & repentance: arrogance, bitterness, sowing discord, gossip, backbiting, slander character of others, contentious, criticize harshly and unlovingly, judgmental, prideful, boastful, doubt, covetousness, lying, allowing your mind to harbor impure thoughts, disobedient to God and authority, walking in the flesh & trying to solve problems on your own, jealousy, malice, hateful, envy, harboring resentment, refusing to make restitution, unjust anger,

anxiousness, hypocrisy, impatient, dishonest, stealing time and money that belongs to God, no longer on fire for God, no longer long for the demonstration of God's power, prayerlessness, failure to confess Jesus openly, speaking against God's children, negative thoughts, bad attitude, greed, corrupt & filthy conversation, despising correction, causing division, lack of faith, conforming to the standards of the world, failing to respect spiritual authority, habits that abuse your body.. (James 1:19, 4:17; Eph. 4:29, 5:3-6; 1 Cor. 6:9-10; 2 Cor. 7:1, 1 Thes. 5:12-13; Gal. 5:19-21; Psalms 19:14; Rev. 22:12-16; Matt. 5:28)

Lord, let revival begin in our COMMUNITY - Week 2 ~ January 13th

- Pray a prayer of repentance for our city – we confess that we are inhabitants of this land and have sinned greatly against you. (Nehemiah 1:7, Jeremiah 2:13, Psalms 51:4, Exodus 34:6-7, Isaiah 53:6)

PRAY THAT THE CITY WILL BE TRANSFORMED:

- Pray that the city and community will be invaded by the grace and presence of God and that the divine fire will fall
- The Kingdom values will be celebrated publicly and passed on to the future generation
- Economic conditions will improve and lead to a visible lessening of poverty. (2 Chronicles 17:3-5; Psalms 144:13-14; Isaiah 60:5-7; Amos 9:13)
- Christians will recognize their responsibility to heal and undergird the community (Isaiah 58:10-12; 61:1-4)
- Restored hope and joy will lead to a decline in divorce, bankruptcy and suicide (Nehemiah 12:27-28, 43; Isaiah 54:11-14, 61:3-7; Jeremiah 30:17-19, 31:11-13; Hosea 2:15)
- Crime corruption will diminish throughout the community, (2 Kings 12:13-15; Nehemiah 5:6-12; Isaiah 60:17-18)
- Pray for the **churches** in the community. Pray for unity to break out amongst the churches in the community; pray that churches will band together as a unified army to effectively win the lost;

pray that they will reach out to the community with the love of Jesus; pray that they will be strategic in being a blessing; pray that God will bring healing among members; pray that they will be houses of prayer (1 Kings 18:21-39; Acts 2:41-47, Hebrews 10:23-25; John 13:35; Matt. 5:13-14; John 17; Psalms 85:6)

- Pray for healing, restoration and revival into **families**; pray against the spirit of rebellion; pray for restoration of the family altars in the homes; pray for protection spiritually, physically, emotionally, and mentally; ask God to strengthen marriages (Psalms 68:5-6; Genesis 1:26-28, 12:3; Ephesians 3:14-15; Acts 16:31-32; Psalms 107:41; Psalms 127:1-5)
- Pray for the **educational system** - educators, students, parents, administrators. Pray for conviction and salvation among those who can influence and bring change; pray for wisdom and knowledge for the educators; pray that Christian students will stand strong for their faith. (Deut. 6:5-9; Psalms 25:4, 34:11, 90:12; 1 Cor. 2:12-16)
- Pray for Christian influence in the **government**, pray that God will raise up Godly leaders; pray for conviction and that they will acknowledge their sin and dependency on God; pray for wisdom on their behalf; pray that their decisions will honor God; pray that they will be a people of prayer (1 Peter 2:13-17; 1 Tim 2:1-2; Prov. 3:6; 2 Kings 11:17-18, 23:1-3; Psalm 2:8; 1 Timothy 2:1-4; Luke 22:46)
- Pray for truth and righteousness to infiltrate our **media** – in print, television and internet. Ask God to bring a spirit of integrity to the writers, producers, broadcasters, journalists; ask God to raise up Godly men and women; pray that the community will be wise consumers of information and opinions; pray for the Christian media ministries that shares the gospel. (James 3:4-6; Philippians 4:8; Psalms 101:3; John 16:3)
- Pray that the relationships of Christians in the **arts and entertainment** will stay pure, that their eyes will be upon the Lord, and they will be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit. Pray that the hearts of the people in the community will be

open to respond to Lord's message in their work. (Psalms 101:3, 96:1-3, Revelation 14:7)

- Pray for the **businesses** in the community that they will be governed by a spirit of integrity and generosity; pray that selfish exploitation and corruption will be exposed; pray for a spirit of wisdom on their behalf.

Lord, let revival begin in our CHURCH – Week 3 ~ January 20th

- Pray that God will give the church a fresh vision of the Lord Jesus Christ; pray that believers will return to their first love; ask God to deal with the immorality in the church; pray that God will convict the believers going through the motions and that God will create in believers a desire to pursue holiness and obedience; pray that God will mold the church into a body that he can powerfully use; pray that God will deal with any hindrances that is keeping the church from being a powerful witness. (Revelation 2 & 3, Isaiah 6:1-5, 1 Peter 1: 15-16)
- Pray that Pastor will be bold, faithful and fearless and will preach the word of God with clarity, power, conviction and authority to bring revival. (1 Cor. 2:1-4; 2 Tim. 3:16, 4:4)
- Pray for unity (Psalms 133:1-3; John 17:23; Philippians 2:2-3); Gal. 3:28; Acts 4:32; Acts 5:12)
- Pray that the brethren will respond to the Lord's call for ministry for missions and service (Matt. 9:37; Acts 16:6- 10)
- Ask God to reveal any obstacles that could hinder the church from experiencing genuine revival; ask God to reveal anything that is not pleasing to Him; ask him to remove anything that is hindering the church to experience a genuine working of the Holy Spirit in revival (Psalms 139:23)
- Pray that God will convict and save any deceived, unregenerate church members (Matthew 7:21-23; 2 Corinthians 13:5-6). There are times when deceived, unregenerate church members work against what God is doing in the church. They cause believers to stumble. Ask God to deal with any members who may be deceived and are not truly saved.
- Pray that the church will be about the great commission; that God will grant the church a burden for the lost people of every

ethnic group; pray that the church will develop a constant desire to share the gospel, and that the church will develop a culture of discipleship (Matthew 28:18-20; 2 Corin. 5:10; Romans 9:1-3, 1 Timothy 2:1, 3, 4)

- Ask God to add new and diverse believers to the church. (Acts 2:40-47)
- Pray that the church places a high priority on the Word of God (Neh. 8.1-8 & 2 Tim. 3:10-17)
- Pray that the brethren will be devoted to pray and that the church will become a house of prayer. (Mark 11:17, Matt. 21:13; Col. 4:2-4)
- Pray for the leaders of the church, that they will keep their eyes on God; they will not take a step apart from God's leading; not rely on their own strength; be wise in leading God's people; weep over the sins and failures of God's people; they will know when to push away from the crowds to pray; they will walk worthy of their calling; that they will finish well. (2. Chron. 20:12; Ex. 33:15; 2 Samuel 24:10; 1 Kings 3:9; Nehemiah 1:4; Luke 5:15-16; Col. 1:9-10)
- Pray that God will raise up new leaders and provide a plan for development (2 Tim. 2:2)
